### **ALL STUDENTS**

#### **EMERGENCY MEDICAL CONSENT - FOR ALL STUDENTS**

**Each student** is to have a current **EMERGENCY MEDICAL CONSENT FORM** in his file. Please read it carefully, complete, and return it to school prior to or upon the first day of school.

If you need to provide more information than there is room for, please use the back of the form. (The student health record is kept in strict confidence.)

#### **IMMUNIZATIONS- ALL STUDENTS**

In order to enter school (kindergarten or first grade) the student **must have** four doses of the Diphtheria and Tetanus vaccine, three doses of the polio vaccine, two doses of the MMR vaccine, and three doses of the Hepatitis B. One dose of varicella (chicken pox) is required. HIB is not required for school. Please have your physician's office fill in the required areas. ("Up-to-date" or "completed" cannot be accepted.) Because of the required immunization information.

### **Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>**

#### **PHYSICAL EXAMINATION - Pre-K, Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>**

In compliance with the Pennsylvania Health & Safety Code, Title 28, students are required to have a **physical examination** in grades **Pre-K, K, 6<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>**. The form is completed by the doctor and returned to the school by the beginning of school for pre-k and kindergarten and by the Christmas holidays for 6<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders.

### **K, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>**

#### **DENTAL EXAMINATIONS - K, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>**

Also in compliance with the health code, students in **K, third and seventh** are required to have **dental examinations**. Please have your dentist complete the **Dental examination** form and return it to the school no later than the Christmas holiday.

Thank you so much for your cooperation. If you are unable to afford the cost of the immunizations through your child's physician, you may want to call the Department of Public Health at 677 - 0672 to arrange obtaining them there. The cost is based upon your income.
